- Head Coach Adam Gase and the Miami Dolphins had to wait a little longer to take the field for the first time this season as the start of tonight's contest was delayed 50 minutes due to severe weather.
- After tonight's win, the Dolphins are now 23-27-1 in preseason openers in franchise history.
- After tonight's win, the Dolphins are now 13-14 in preseason openers on the road in franchise history.
- LB Kiko Alonso, LS John Denney, LB Koa Misi, C Mike Pouncey, and QB Ryan Tannehill served as tonight's game captains.

POSTGAME NOTES

- **DE Julius Warmlesley** recorded each of the first two sacks for the Dolphins. Warmlesley has yet to appear in a regular season NFL game, but did record one sack in the 2015 preseason as a member of the Seattle Seahawks.
- **CB Bobby McCain** intercepted N.Y. Giants QB Ryan Nassib at the 8:04 mark of the second quarter. It was McCain's first interception (regular season or preseason) since he was selected by the Dolphins in the fifth round (145th overall) of the 2015 NFL draft.
- **K Andrew Franks** gave the Dolphins their first points of the preseason with a 49-yard field goal with 4:48 remaining in the first half. Franks was 13-of-16 (81.3 pct.) during the 2015 regular season and a perfect 3-for-3 (100.0 pct.) during the 2015 preseason in field goal attempts.
- **S Walt Aikens** strip-sacked N.Y. Giants QB Ryan Nassib at the Giants 35-yard line with 3:18 left in the second quarter. The fumble was recovered by **LB Spencer Paysinger**, who returned the loose ball 24 yards to the Giants 7-yard line before it was fumbled out of bounds. The turnover was Miami's second of the quarter and led to 5-yard touchdown carry by **RB Damien Williams** that tied the game at 10.
- **RB Damien Williams** scored Miami's first touchdown of the preseason on a 5-yard carry with 3:03 left in the first half. The score tied the game at 10. Williams has not rushed for a touchdown in a regular season game during his two seasons (2014-15) with the Dolphins but has reeled in two touchdown receptions.
- The Dolphins recorded their third turnover of the second quarter off a pass that was deflected by **CB Lafayette Pitts** and ultimately picked off by **S A.J. Hendy** with 1:40 remaining in the second quarter. The interception was Hendy's first of the preseason and marked the first time Miami had forced three turnovers in one quarter of a preseason game since they forced three in the second quarter of a 10-7 win vs. Tampa Bay on Aug. 14, 2010.
- The Dolphins continued their second-quarter scoring with a 51-yard touchdown strike from **QB Matt Moore** to **WR Matt Hazel** to give Miami a 17-10 lead with 49 seconds left in the first half. Hazel also caught a touchdown on a 4-yard reception from Moore in the Aug. 22, 2015 preseason game at Carolina.
- With 17 points in the second quarter, Miami erased a 10-point deficit and gave themselves a 17-10 lead heading into halftime. All 17 points came off turnovers. The last time the Dolphins scored 17 points in one quarter of a preseason contest was on Oct. 4, 2013 when they scored 17 points in the fourth quarter against the Dallas Cowboys in the Hall of Fame Game.

POSTGAME NOTES

- **K Marshall Koehn** converted his lone field goal and extra point attempts in his first action with the Dolphins. A rookie from Iowa, Koehn was signed as an undrafted college free agent on May 6, 2016.
- **DT Deandre Coleman** recovered a fourth-quarter fumble from QB Logan Thomas, which was Miami's fourth takeaway of the game.
- **QB Zac Dysert** found **TE Thomas Duarte** for a 16-yard touchdown pass along the right side. A rookie, it was Duarte's first preseason reception as an NFL player. For Dysert, it was his third preseason touchdown pass after he spent the 2013-15 preseasons with the Denver Broncos.
- The following players did not travel with the team and missed tonight's game due to injury: **CB Chimdi Chekwa** (thigh), **RB Kenyan Drake** (hamstring), **TE MarQueis Gray** (leg), **DE Farrington Huguenin** (ankle), **DT Earl Mitchell** (calf) and **G Winston Painter** (neck).
- The following players traveled with the team but did not dress: **RB Arian Foster**, **DE Jason Jones**, **S Reshad Jones**, **CB Byron Maxwell**, **WR DeVante Parker**, **DT Ndamukong Suh**, **DE Cameron Wake** and **DE Mario Williams**.
- The following players did not play due to roster designations/injuries: **CB Chris Culliver** (PUP), **CB Xavien Howard** (PUP), **DE Dion Jordan** (NFI) and **LB Zach Vigil** (NFI).
