Notes:

- After tonight's win, the Dolphins are now 127-101-4 (.556) in the preseason in franchise history.
- After tonight's win, the Dolphins are now 2-1 (.667) in preseason games played in Orlando (all at Camping World Stadium).
- QB Ryan Tannehill took off on a quarterback keeper for 22 yards on the first offensive snap of the game. The 22-yard carry was the longest preseason rush of Tannehill's career.
- DE Cameron Wake returned to game action tonight for the first time since suffering an Achilles injury on Oct. 29, 2015 at New England. On his first snap from scrimmage, he hit Falcons QB Matt Ryan, causing an incompletion on third down and forcing Atlanta's first punt of the game.
- On a fourth-and-1 attempt in a 0-0 game with 4:37 left in the first quarter, **DT Ndamukong Suh** stuffed a run up the middle for a 1-yard loss, ending Atlanta's possession and letting the Dolphins offense take over at the Atlanta 48-yard line. The Dolphins went on to score and take a 7-0 lead.
- RB Arian Foster scored on a 2-yard carry with 13:55 remaining in the second quarter. It was Foster's first score of the preseason after he joined the Dolphins as a free agent on July 31, 2016. The touchdown capped off a 12-play, 48-yard drive that took 5:41 off the clock.
- With 11:21 left in the first half, S Reshad Jones intercepted Falcons QB Matt Ryan on a third-and-goal play from the 8-yard line. It was Jones' first interception of the preseason after he led the team in the category in the 2015 regular season with five interceptions.
- **QB Ryan Tannehill** exited the game at halftime after he completed 20 of 29 passes for 155 yards. It was the most completions in a game this preseason for Tannehill.
- S Michael Thomas created Miami's second turnover of the game in the third quarter after he stripped Falcons TE Austin Hooper after a 23-yard reception. Thomas recovered the fumble himself and the Dolphins scored a touchdown on the ensuing possession to take a 14-3 lead.
- Following the Thomas fumble recovery, **RB Damien Williams** took a 2-yard plunge into the end zone to give the Dolphins a 14-3 lead with 11:22 left in the third quarter. It was Williams' second touchdown of the preseason.

- DE Julius Warmsley recorded a fourth-quarter sack his third of the preseason. His three preseason sacks lead the team and is the most by a Dolphins player in the preseason since LB Tristan Okpalaugo in 2013.
- T Ja'Wuan James, LB Jelani Jenkins, LB Spencer Paysinger, RB Daniel Thomas and DE Cameron Wake served as tonight's game captains.
