#### Notes:

- LS John Denney extended his consecutive games played streak to 178, most in franchise history.
- WR Jarvis Landry (137 yards) and WR DeVante Parker (106 yards) each topped 100 receiving yards today. It marked the first time two Dolphins players have accomplished this in the same game since WR Rishard Matthews (115 yards) and Landry (110 yards) did so at Jacksonville on Sept. 20, 2015.
- WR Jarvis Landry posted the fourth 100-yard receiving game of his career before the conclusion of the third quarter. He totaled 137 receiving yards for his first 100-yard receiving game since Dec. 27, 2015 vs. Indianapolis.
- With 10 receptions for 137 yards today, WR Jarvis Landry went over 2,000 career receiving yards today in just his 34th career game. Landry becomes the second fastest Dolphin to reach 2,000 career receiving yards after WR Mark Duper did so in 28 career games.
- WR Jarvis Landry's 10 receptions are tied for the third-most in his career and his 137 receiving yards rank No. 2 in his career.





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- **WR DeVante Parker's** posted statistically the best performance of his career today. His eight receptions were a career high and his 106 receiving yards match his career high set in the last game he played, Jan. 3, 2016 vs. New England.
- All of **WR DeVante Parker's** eight receptions for 106 yards came in the second half. He is the first Dolphins player to have 100-plus receiving yards in a half since **WR Jarvis Landry** gained 115 yards in the air in the second half at the N.Y. Jets on Nov. 29, 2015.
- **QB Ryan Tannehill** posted one of the best statistical performances of his career. His 389 passing yards rank No. 3 in his five-year NFL career, while his 32 completions are also third.
- In the second half, **QB Ryan Tannehill** was 22-of-27 for 273 yards, two touchdowns and a 118.1 passer rating. It is the most passing yards by Tannehill in the second half of a game in his career.
- **QB Ryan Tannehill** connected with **WR Kenny Stills** for a 24-yard touchdown pass in the third quarter. The play was Stills' longest since Dec. 14, 2015 when he caught a 47-yard touchdown on Monday Night Football vs. the N.Y. Giants.
- **DT Ndamukong Suh** set a career high with 12 tackles in today's contest, breaking his previous high mark of 10 at Philadelphia on Dec. 8, 2013. The 12 tackles also led the team today.
- **LB Jelani Jenkins** made his 200th career tackle in the first quarter of today's game. With five stops this afternoon, Jenkins now has 202 career tackles.
- With 13 receiving yards in the first half, **TE Jordan Cameron** topped the 2,000-yard mark for his career. Cameron finished the contest with five receptions for 49 yards and a touchdown, giving him 172 career receptions for 2,041 yards.
- With **K Andrew Franks'** 27-yard field goal in the second quarter, it marked the fourth consecutive game, dating back to 2015, that Franks has made a field goal. It is the longest streak of Franks' his career and is the longest the Dolphins have had since **K Caleb Sturgis** had a 10-game streak snapped on Nov. 23, 2014.
- **RB Kenyan Drake** made it a one possession game with a 7-yard touchdown run with 6:06 remaining. The touchdown was the first of the rookie's career. Drake rushed for 18 touchdowns in his four-year career at Alabama.





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- DT **Chris Jones** made his Miami Dolphins debut today. Jones played in 28 games and made 23 starts with the Patriots in 2013 and 2014.
- S **Isa Abdul-Quddus**, T **Branden Albert**, S **Reshad Jones**, QB **Ryan Tannehill**, S **Michael Thomas** and DE **Cameron Wake** served as today's game captains.
- The following players were inactive today: LB **Donald Butler**, WR **Justin Hunter**, CB **Jordan Lucas**, RB **Isaiah Pead**, C **Mike Pouncey**, G **Dallas Thomas** and RB **Damien Williams**.
