With today's win, the Dolphins are now 58-42-1 against Buffalo all-time in the regular season.

Notes:

- With today's win, the Dolphins have now won four of their past five home games, dating back to the 2015 – the last time Miami won four of five home games was during the 2012-13 seasons.
- The Dolphins have now won back-to-back games for the first time since Oct. 18 (at Tennessee) and Oct. 25, 2015 (vs. Houston).
- Today's win is the third home win of the season, matching the team's total from 2015.
- With 214 rushing yards today, **RB Jay Ajayi** became the fourth player (fifth time overall) in NFL history to rush for 200 yards in consecutive games, joining O.J. Simpson in 1973 and 1976, Earl Campbell in 1980 and Ricky Williams in 2002. He rushed for 204 yards last week vs. Pittsburgh.
- With **RB Jay Ajayi's** 214 rushing yards and **WR Kenny Stills'** 100 receiving yards, the Dolphins became the first NFL team since Sept. 16, 2007 (Cleveland) to have a 200-yard rusher and a 100-yard receiver in the same game.
- **RB Jay Ajayi** rushed for 115 yards in the second half, helping Miami overcome a 10-6 halftime deficit for the win. The 115 second-half rushing yards are the fifth-most in team history. Ajayi rushed for a team-record 153 yards in the second half of last week's win vs. Pittsburgh.

- **RB Jay Ajayi** now has the two highest single-game (214 today, 204 last week vs. Pittsburgh) and second-half (115 today, 153 last week vs. Pittsburgh) rushing totals in the NFL in 2016.
- **RB Jay Ajayi** now owns two of the top five rushing performances in team history, with both coming in the past two games. Here is a look at the top five single-game rushing totals in Dolphins history:

- **RB Jay Ajayi** had nine runs of 10-plus yards today, which is tied for the third highest single-game total in the NFL since 1960.
- **RB Jay Ajayi** topped the 100-yard mark for the second time in as many games. The two 100-yard rushing games are the first two of his career and mark the 22nd time in team history that a Dolphins running back has had at least two straight games with 100-plus yards. The last time a Dolphins back had consecutive 100-yard rushing games was **RB Lamar Miller**, who topped the plateau on Oct. 18 and Oct. 25, 2015 at Tennessee and vs. Houston, respectively.
- **RB Jay Ajayi** rushed for 99 yards in the first half of the game. The 99 yards are tied for the eighth-most in the first half of a game by a Dolphins player since 1991 and are the most since **RB Lamar Miller** had 175 first-half rushing yards on Oct. 25, 2015 vs. Houston.
- The Dolphins trailed 17-6 in the third quarter and 17-14 in the fourth quarter before overcoming the deficit to post a 28-25 win. The fourth-quarter comeback was the 10th of **QB Ryan Tannehill's** career and his first since Nov. 15, 2015 at Philadelphia.
- **QB Ryan Tannehill** essentially sealed the victory with a 66-yard touchdown strike to **WR Kenny Stills** with 2:24 remaining in the game to put Miami up 28-17. The completion marked a career-high five games that Tannehill has hit on a pass of 50-plus yards this season. He is the only quarterback in the NFL that has five games with a 50-plus yard completion (at of the conclusion of today's 1 p.m. games).

POSTGAME NOTES

- DE **Cameron Wake** recorded 1.5 sacks today, giving him 73.0 for his career. Wake is second in team history and sixth among undrafted NFL players in career sacks.
- DT **Ndamukong Suh** recorded a sack in the fourth quarter, giving him 45.5 for his career. He is tied with Cincinnati Bengals DT **Geno Atkins** for the most sacks by a defensive tackle since he entered the NFL in 2010.
- WR **Jarvis Landry** scored his second career 2-point conversion, tying the team record for most career 2-point conversions with WR **Irving Fryar** (1993-95) and WR **Marty Booker** (2004-07).
- DE **Jason Jones** recorded a sack in the third quarter, topping the 30-sack mark for his career. He now has 30.5 career sacks.
- LS **John Denney** played in his 183rd career game today, moving into a tie for fourth place with former Dolphins WR **Nat Moore** on the team's all-time games played list.
- LS **John Denney** extended his consecutive games played streak to 183, the longest in franchise history.
- DE **Andre Branch**, LS **John Denney**, C **Mike Pouncey**, QB **Ryan Tannehill**, S **Michael Thomas** and DE **Cameron Wake** served as today's game captains.
- The following players were inactive today: CB **Bené Benwikere**, TE **Jordan Cameron**, DE **Terrence Fede**, CB **Xavien Howard**, TE **Dion Sims**, DE **Julius Warmesley** and DE **Nick Williams**.
