Notes:

- With today's win, the Dolphins have now won five of their past six home games, dating back to the 2015 season. The last time Miami went 5-1 over six straight home games was 2011-12.
- The Dolphins have now won three consecutive games for the first time since Oct. 19 – Nov. 2, 2014.
- Today's win is the fourth home win of the season, surpassing the team's total of three home wins in 2015 and matching the team's four home wins in the 2014 season.
- **RB Jay Ajayi** rushed for 111 yards against the Jets. It marked his third consecutive game with 100-plus yards. The last Dolphins running back who had three-or-more consecutive games with 100-plus yards was Reggie Bush, who had four consecutive games with 100-or-more yards in 2011. Ajayi has now rushed for a total of 529 yards in his past three games.
- **RB Jay Ajayi** rushed for a 20-yard touchdown to cap off Miami's first offensive possession. The touchdown was Ajayi's sixth of the season and marks the fourth consecutive game he has rushed for a touchdown. Ajayi is one of just three NFL players this season to rush for a touchdown in four consecutive games, joining New England's LeGarrette Blount and San Diego's Melvin Gordon.
** Tennessee RB DeMarco Murray has an active three-game streak and plays today at 4:25 p.m.*
- Miami rushed for 137 net yards today, the second-most the Jets have allowed in a single game this season. The Jets entered the game with the NFL's top-ranked rush defense, allowing just 74.0 yards per game.
- **RB Kenyan Drake's** 96-yard kickoff return for a touchdown was tied for the sixth-longest kickoff return in team history (including playoffs) and the team's first kickoff return for a touchdown since Marcus





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Thigpen had a 96-yard touchdown on Nov. 15, 2012 at Buffalo. It was also the second-longest kickoff return by a rookie in team history (Mercury Morris, 105 yards, at Cincinnati, Sept. 14, 1969)

- **Drake's** kickoff return for a touchdown marks the fifth time in team history that the Dolphins have had a kickoff return and a punt return for a touchdown in the same season (2012, 1989, 1981, 1970). **WR Jakeem Grant** had a 74-yard punt return for a touchdown vs. Tennessee on Oct. 9, 2016.
- **DE Cameron Wake** recorded two strip-sacks in the first half, his 15th career game with two-or-more sacks and his first this season. His 15 games of two-or-more sacks rank No. 2 in team history behind **DE/LB Jason Taylor** (25). It's the 18th multiple-sack performance of Wake's career and the fourth time he has forced at least two fumbles in a game.
- **QB Ryan Tannehill** went 11-of-13 (84.6 pct.) for 98 yards and one touchdown in the first half, posting a quarterback rating of 123.7. It was the sixth-highest quarterback rating in the first half of a game in Tannehill's career and his highest since he had a perfect 158.3 rating in the first half vs. Houston on Oct. 25, 2015.
- The Dolphins trailed 23-20 in the fourth quarter before overcoming the deficit to post a 27-23 win. The fourth-quarter comeback was the 11th of **QB Ryan Tannehill's** career and his second of the 2016 season.
- **DT Jordan Phillips** became the 11th interior defensive lineman (defensive tackle or nose tackle) in Dolphins history to record an interception when he picked off a third-quarter pass by Jets QB Ryan Fitzpatrick and returned it 17 yards, setting up a Dolphins field goal to take a 20-13 lead. It was the first time an interior defensive lineman had intercepted a pass since Oct. 7, 2012 when **DT Randy Starks** intercepted Bengals QB Andy Dalton. Phillips is only the third interior defensive tackle in the NFL this season to have an interception (Minnesota DT Tom Johnson and San Diego NT Brandon Mebane).
- **TE Dominique Jones** had a productive first half for the Dolphins. He caught two passes for 25 yards in the half, the first coming on a career-long 24-yard reception. His second catch was a 1-yard score, giving him the first touchdown of his career and the Dolphins a 14-10 lead.
- **RB Damien Williams** set a new career long when he took a carry 23 yards in the second quarter.
- **WR Jarvis Landry** caught three passes for 33 yards (11.0 avg.), pushing him past the 2,500 career receiving yards mark. He now has 2,520 career receiving yards.





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- **WR Jarvis Landry** had a pass attempt in the second quarter. It was his second career pass attempt and he is one only five wide receivers in Dolphins history to have two or more career pass attempts, joining **Nat Moore** (2), **Mark Clayton** (2), **Marty Booker** (3) and **Marlin Briscoe** (4).
- **LS John Denney** played in his 184th career game today, moving past former Dolphins **WR Nat Moore** and into sole possession of fourth place on the team's all-time games played list.
- **LS John Denney** extended his consecutive games played streak to 184, the longest in franchise history.
- **LS John Denney**, **C Mike Pouncey**, **QB Ryan Tannehill**, **DT Ndamukong Suh**, **S Michael Thomas** and **DE Cameron Wake** served as today's game captains.
- The following players were inactive today: **CB Bené Benwikere**, **CB Xavien Howard**, **DE Terrence Fede**, **CB Jordan Lucas**, **TE Dion Sims**, **DE Nick Williams** and **T Sam Young**.
