#### Notes:

- **WR Jakeem Grant** returned a punt 74 yards for a touchdown in the second quarter, the first touchdown of the rookie's career. It was Miami's first punt return for a touchdown since Sept. 13, 2015 when **WR Jarvis Landry** had a 69-yard punt return for a touchdown at Washington. Grant's return was also the seventh longest in team history and fourth longest by a Dolphins rookie.
- **RB Damien Williams** caught a 58-yard pass in the second quarter that set up a touchdown drive for Miami. Williams' catch was the longest of his career and the 11th-longest by a running back in team history. The last time a Dolphins running back had a catch of at least 58 yards was on Oct. 12, 2009 vs. the N.Y. Jets when **RB Ricky Williams** had a 59-yard reception.
- **RB Jay Ajayi** rushed for a 4-yard touchdown in the second quarter. It was his second touchdown of the season and third of his career. The touchdown capped off a six-play, 79-yard scoring drive for the Dolphins.
- **WR DeVante Parker** caught a 50-yard pass in the third quarter, the longest of his career. It was Tannehill's second pass of 50-plus yards in the game after he previously connected with **RB Damien Williams** on a 58-yard completion. It is the fourth game of Tannehill's career with two or more 50-yard completions in the same game and the first since Oct. 25, 2015 vs. Houston when Tannehill had three passes of 50-plus yards.

### POSTGAME NOTES

- **DE Jason Jones** blocked a PAT in the fourth quarter, his second blocked PAT of the season (his other was Sept. 11, 2016 at Seattle). The team record for the most blocked PATs by a Dolphins player in a single season is three by **LB Wahoo McDaniel** in the team's inaugural season in 1966.
- With 12 total tackles (eight solo) today, **LB Kiko Alonso** set a season high and topped the 250 career tackles plateau. His career tackle total is now 252.
- **DE Jason Jones** played in his 100th NFL game today. Jones is in his ninth NFL season, having played for Tennessee (2008-11), Seattle (2012), Detroit (2013-15) and Miami (2016).
- **DE Mario Williams** started his 150th NFL contest. Williams has totaled 393 tackles (313 solo) and 97 sacks in his 11-year NFL career.
- **LS John Denney** extended his consecutive games played streak to 181, the most in franchise history.
- **G Billy Turner** made his first NFL start today at left tackle. He started 30 games at left tackle in college at North Dakota State.
- **TE MarQueis Gray** made his first start for the Dolphins today. He was signed on April 1, 2016.
- **DE Jason Jones, S Reshad Jones, C Mike Pouncey, QB Ryan Tannehill, S Michael Thomas and DE Cameron Wake** served as today's game captains.
- The following players were inactive today: **T Branden Albert, TE Jordan Cameron, RB Arian Foster, CB Xavien Howard, LB Jelani Jenkins, LB Koa Misi and G/T Laremy Tunsil.**
